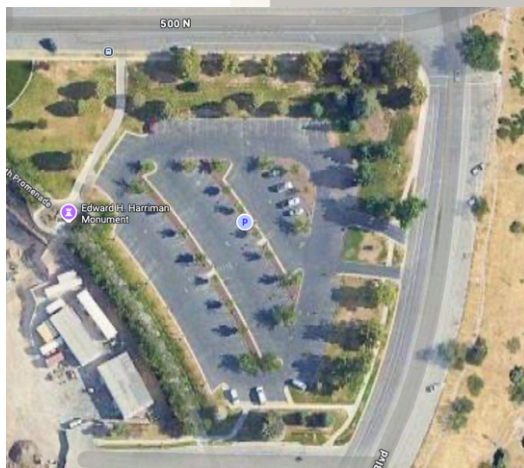

## World Events That Happened This Month in 1976

On May 16th, the Montreal Canadiens won game 4 of the 1976 Stanley Cup Finals with Guy Lafleur scoring the clinching goal and sweeping the Philadelphia Flyers to win the club's 19th Stanley Cup in franchise history. The Canadiens have gone on to win 5 more Stanley Cups and hold the record for most Stanley Cups won by a franchise with 24.

On May 24th Muhammad Ali would defeat Richard Dunn with a round 5 TKO defending his heavyweight boxing title. This would also be Ali's last TKO of his career.

On May 25th, Johnny Rutherford won the 1976 Indianapolis 500, his second of three victories, driving the #2 Bruce McLaren Motor Racing Team McLaren-Offenhauser. The race was shortened to 102 laps (255 miles) of the scheduled 200 laps due to heavy rain, making it the shortest Indy 500 in history at the time.

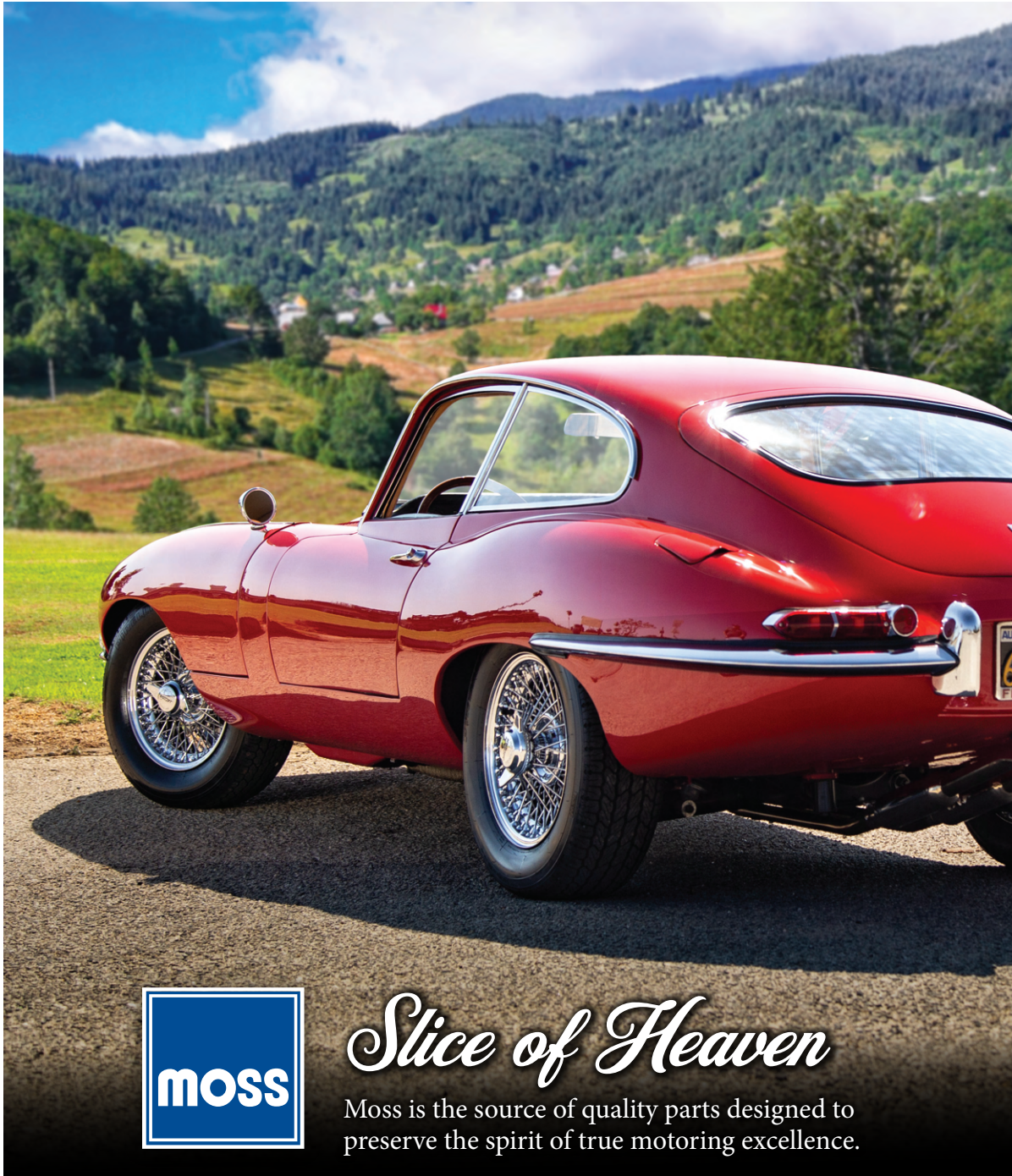
